Best Practices for Repelling Deer and Rabbils

Alternate Products: Deer and rabbits can become accustomed to repellents over time. Rotating products increases

long-term effectiveness.

Apply Early: Start using repellents before deer and rabbits begin feeding to discourage habits. Reapply After Rain: Most repellents need to be reapplied after heavy rain unless labeled as rain-resistant. Use Both Liquid and Granular: Create a strong defense by combining liquid sprays on plants with granular barriers around beds and perimeters.
